

Prof. Dongping FANG, PhD

Dr. Dongping FANG is a Professor and head at Dept. of Construction Management, School of Civil Engineering, Tsinghua University, one of China's Premier Universities. He is the director of (Tsinghua-Gammon) Construction Safety Research Center based at Tsinghua University. His research, teaching and consulting are in the area of safety and risk management in construction and safety analysis of RC buildings during construction. He has published more than 120 papers and three books in English, Japanese and Chinese. Some of the papers have been published in highly ranked journals, such as ASCE Journals and Safety Science.

Dongping is a member of MCC and guest to the board of CIB (International Council for Research and Innovation in Building and Construction) and a member of CIOB (Chartered Institute of Building). He hosted the CIB W99 international conference on global unity for safety and health in construction in 2006 and edited the conference proceedings which have been officially published.

Dongping is the vice chair of Construction Safety Specialist Committee, the Ministry of Housing and Urban-rural Construction and a national work safety expert nominated by the State Administration of Work Safety in China.

He is honored as Visiting Eminent Scholar in 2006 at the Del E. Webb School of Construction, Arizona State University, USA; "2007 Anniversary Professor" at Chalmers University of Technology, Sweden; and Visiting Professor at UNSW, Australia (2006-2009). In May 2008, he was awarded the International Construction Project Management Association ICPMA Award of CIOB due to the contribution to a risk management system for the venue construction of 2008 Beijing Olympics.
