

**Mr Peter Godfrey**

*National President of Engineers Australia*



Peter Godfrey is the National President of Engineers Australia, an organisation of nearly 90,000 members that is dedicated to promoting and advancing the science and practice of engineering. He is a civil engineer whose thirty year professional career spans employment with several major companies in various senior management roles. A decade ago he started his own consultancy practice, BAS Consulting, which has a focus on business improvement, asset management and project management activities.

Peter is also a past president of Engineers Australia's Tasmania Division, former chair of the Civil College Board and has been a member of National Council for the past five years. His leadership in the engineering profession has led to his membership of a number of influential groups. Alongside Bill Wild, he was a key initiator and member of the Safer Construction Taskforce, comprising representatives from industry, government and professional bodies, which produced the Guide to Best Practice for Safer Construction. Peter has been a Director of the Australian Council for Built Environment Design Professions, a member of the National Engineering Registration Board and the National Board of the Centre for Engineering Leadership and Management. He has also chaired, or currently chairs a number of Engineers Australia's committees including the Engineering Practice Taskforce for the Future, the Engineering Team Task Force, the International Committee, the Bye-laws Committee and the Steering Committee for 2010: Year of Engineering Leadership. These roles have provided important input into the direction of engineering in Australia as well as guiding our engagement with international engineering groups. Peter was included in Engineers Australia Magazine's Top 100 of Australia's most influential engineers.
